Heather Mitchell Announces Campaign for 2nd District

Stafford – Today, Heather Mitchell, mother of three and the spouse of an active duty prior-enlisted Marine Corps Officer, announced her campaign for the Virginia House of Delegates in the 2nd District. Heather previously ran in 2019 and is now running once again to replace former Delegate Jennifer Carroll Foy, who has recently abandoned her constituents to seek higher office.
